

As PROM season draws near, please keep in mind the following rules:

AGE:

- Your guest must be at least a 9th grader. All attendees must be enrolled in school, have a diploma, have a GED, or have been pursuing a GED by being enrolled in classes by Jan. 1 2015.
- Your guest cannot equal or be older than age 21.

DRESS CODE: REMEMBER – it is your job to share these rules with your guest if they are not a student here at PCHS.

- JEWELRY – is prohibited when worn in any visible body part other than the ear or nose. Only small studs are allowed in nose.
- Tuxedo coats may be removed after Grand March, but the dress shirt must remain on and buttoned during prom.
- Students may not wear hats that are not considered formal wear.
- No one may wear sunglasses during grand march.
- PROM DRESSES-
 - ❖ May not reveal cleavage
 - ❖ May not have cutouts that reveal skin on the front or sides of the dress (no 2-pieces that show skin)
 - ❖ May not have sheer, skin-toned fabric that gives the illusion of bare skin in places that it should not be showing bare skin
 - ❖ May not be shorter than fingertip length (this includes slits in dress)

***Please be responsible when choosing your dress for PROM. We are going to eliminate turning in pictures of your dress for approval, however if these rules are violated you will be asked to leave and not walk through Grand March or attend the Ball Room until you have appropriate attire. If you have a question about the dress you choose, please bring a picture to Mrs. Tharp or Mrs. Fiscus for approval.
